Guidelines for Show

Goat

- * Animals exhibiting external parasites, soremouth or other contagious diseases are not allowed to show. Health inspector has final say at check in point.
- * Changes to animal ID or class changes can/must be made during final registration morning of show.
- * Class premiums prorated to top 3 in class
- * Pens and show area must be cleaned out upon departure.
- * Open to youth 21 years old & under as of 1-1-2018.
- * Goats need permanent USDA identification.
- * Out of state goat exhibitors should have health papers available upon request.
- * All MBGA rules apply. Market does and wethers are eligible to show by weight. Weights will be declared and submitted to show staff by 9:30 a.m.
- * The first and second place goats may be re-weighed in class. Goats that are more than 5 pounds above the declared weight will be disqualified from the show and all other goats will move up one placing in class.

Sheep

- * Market lamb and showmanship classes are open to youth 21 and under as of 1-1-2018. Breeding stock classes are open class.
- * Changes to animal ID or class changes can/must be made during final registration morning of show.
- * You may show from pens or trailer but *pens must be reserved by May 10.*
- * Market lambs will show by breed with a minimum of 5 needed to make a class for a breed. Breeds with less than 5 head may show in an AOB class.
- * All sheep must have USDA identification tags and out of state exhibitors should have health papers for interstate transportation available upon request.
- * Lambs will show in the class they are declared. The first and second place lambs may be re-weighed in class. Lambs that are more than 7 pounds above declared weight will be disqualified from the show and all other lambs will move up one placing.
- * The Three Way Futurity is offered for lambs purchased from Three Way Acres with no entry fee but premiums will be paid from a \$500 purse.
- * Animals exhibiting fungus, soremouth or other contagious diseases are not allowed to show. Management reserves the right to excuse animals from the show at any point for health issues.

Swine

- * Entries must be postmarked by May 10. Late entries are double the original fees and pens are not guaranteed.
- * Market and showmanship classes are open to youth 21 and under as of 1-1,-2018. Showmanship classes offered for 7-10, 11-13, 14-17, and 18-21. Showmanship offered for 6 yr & under w/ mentor.
- * Changes to animal ID or class changes can/must be made during final registration morning of show.
- * Class premiums to top 4 in class.
- * Purebreds will show by breed with a minimum of 5 needed for a breed. If there are not enough for a breed, purebreds will show in an AOB class.
- * Crossbreds will show by declared weight.
- * Hogs will show in the class they are assigned.
- * The 1st & 2nd place crossbred hogs may be re-weighed in class. Hogs that are more than 15 pounds above the declared weight will be disqualified from the show and all other hogs will move up one placing in class.
- * All swine shall be individually, uniquely identified with an official USDA ear tag, or only for registered swine, accompanied by registration papers, ear notches, or tattoos per MDARD guidelines.
- * Out of state exhibitors should have health papers for interstate transportation available upon request.
